# **PAST PERFECT - ESTRUTURA**

O PAST PERFECT é um tempo verbal composto que é formado pelo verbo auxiliar TO HAVE no passado mais um verbo principal no particípio passado.

**HAD + VERBO PRINCIPAL NO PARTICÍPIO**



# PAST PERFECT - USO

O ***Past Perfect*** é usado para descrever uma ação que ocorreu no passado, antes de outra ação também passada.

Popularmente conhecido como o “PASSADO DO PASSADO.”

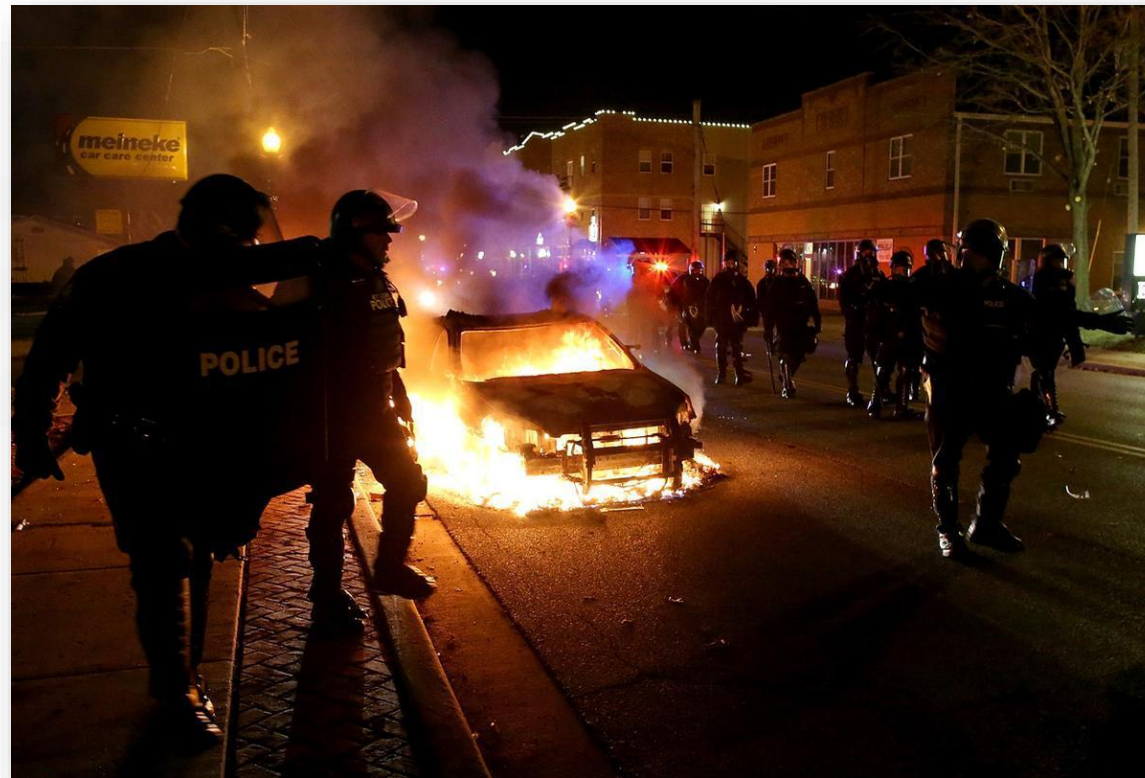
# EXEMPLO:



**I hadn't heard you knocked the door because I was sleeping.**

**(EU NÃO TINHA OUVIDO QUE VOCÊ BATEU À PORTA PORQUE ESTAVA DORMINDO.)**

# EXEMPLO:



Peter **hadn't realized** that the place was so dangerous.

(PETER NÃO TINHA NOTADO QUE O AMBIENTE ERA BASTANTE PERIGOSO. )

**Had** the train already **left** when  
you got to the station?

(O TREM JÁ TINHA SAÍDO QUANDO VOCÊ CHEGOU  
À ESTAÇÃO?)
